1. REF A WAS PREPARED ON AN URGENT BASIS DESIGNED TO PROVIDE AN IMMEDIATE OUTLINE OF ACTIONS FOR OVERT U.S. AIR STRIKES AGAINST THE "94 TARGET" LIST AS A RESULT OF REF B.

2. FOLLOWING THIS ACTION, REF C WAS RECEIVED WHICH PROVIDES AN OUTLINE PLAN OF ACTIONS IN FOUR ATTACK OPTIONS, USING VNAF, FARMGATE AND OVERT U.S. AIRCRAFT. WE ARE CURRENTLY WRITING AN ANNEX TO CINCPAC OPLAN 37-64 USING REF C FOR PLANNING GUIDANCE. THIS ANNEX WILL INCLUDE A SCHEDULE OF SELECTIVE ACTIONS UNDER THE FOUR ATTACK OPTIONS USING VNAF, FARMGATE AND OVERT U.S.

3. THUS, THERE ARE TWO COURSES OF PLANNING UNDERWAY FOR AIR ATTACKS AGAINST THE "94 TARGET" LIST.

A. A STRICTLY OVERT U.S. UNDERTAKING AS A RESULT OF REFS A AND B, AND

B. A COMBINED EFFORT FOLLOWING THE GUIDELINES OF REF C.

4. CINCPACAF, CINCPACFLT AND THEIR SUBORDINATES HAVE BEEN PREPARING, ON A PRIORITY BASIS, DETAILED STRIKE PLANS ON ASSIGNED REF A TARGETS. IT IS INTENDED THAT THE PRODUCTS OF THIS WORK BE ALSO UTILIZED IN THE PREPARATION OF THE 37 PLAN ANNEX. COMUSMACV IN REF D HAS BEEN TASKED TO DEVELOP DETAILED STRIKE PLANS FOR ATTACKS AGAINST THOSE TARGETS THAT VNAF AND FERMGATE (A1H, A1E) MAY BE REQUIRED TO STRIKE IN EXECUTING THE REF C ATTACK OPTIONS. WE ARE PROCEEDING IN THIS EFFORT WITHOUT BENEFIT OF THE FINALIZED JCS TARGET STUDY. IN SUM, ALL THESE DETAILED INDIVIDUAL STRIKE PLANS WILL BE MOLDED INTO ATTACK SCHEDULES IN THE ATTACK OPTIONS OUTLINED IN REF C. THIS PRODUCT WILL BE THE AFOREMENTIONED ANNEX TO CINCPAC OPLAN 37-64.

5. THE FLURRY OF ACTIONS IN SEASIA OVER THE PAST SEVERAL WEEKS, PART OF WHICH DICTATED CONSIDERABLE PREPARATION RESULTING FROM REFS A AND B, HAS SLOWED THE PREPARATION OF THE 37 PLAN ANNEX. IN ADDITION, CHANGES AND ADDENDA TO JCS TARGET STUDY, PLUS ALTERED PRIORITIES OF CERTAIN TARGETS SET FORTH IN REF E, WILL REQUIRE MODIFICATION AND REDIRECTION OF PLANNING ACTIONS NOW BEING ACCOMPLISHED BY COMPONENTS AND SUBORDINATES. AS A RESULT, 37 PLAN ANNEX, INCLUDING SCHEDULE OF DETAILED STRIKE PLANS BY ATTACK OPTION, AND SUBSEQUENT BRIEFING FOR JCS CANNOT BE READIED AS PREVIOUSLY ANTICIPATED BY 2 SEPTEMBER. SUGGEST, THEREFORE, REGARDING PARA 4 OF REF E THAT BRIEFING DATE BE ADJUSTED TO APPROXIMATELY 1 OCTOBER 1964.

6. PARA 3 OF REF E WILL BE ANSWERED SEPARATELY.

FORCES ENVISAGED FOR USE HAVE BEEN MODIFIED TO INCLUDE ONE FARMGATE A1E SQ (18 A/C). BY REF B THE TWO B-57 SQUADS WERE REVERIED FROM THE FARMGATE ROLE, AND ARE NOW INCLUDED IN THE OVERT U.S. FORCE LIST.

3. ON A PRIORITY BASIS, WE ARE ENGAGED IN WRITING AN ANNEX TO CINCPAC OPLAN 37-64 WHICH WILL EXPAND THE REFERENCED OUTLINE PLANS

4. CINCPACAF AND CINCPACFLT ARE CURRENTLY ENGAGED IN ASSIGNING STRIKES AND DEVELOPING DETAILED STRIKE PLANS AGAINST TARGETS LISTED IN REF D. THIS IS A SEPARATE ACTION INVOLVING ONLY OVERT U.S. FORCES, HOWEVER, THE PRODUCTS CAN BE FITTED INTO REF A ATTACK OPTIONS AND THE 37 PLAN ANNEX, WHICH INVOLVES USE OF VNAF, FARMGATE AND OVERT U.S. AIR.

5. IN DEVELOPING THE STRIKE PLAN (ANNEX TO CINCPAC 37-64), BY ATTACK OPTION, ALONG THE LINES OF REF A, IT IS NECESSARY TO SCHEDULE TARGETS FOR ATTACK CONSIDERING THE SORTIE CAPABILITY OF EACH FORCE INVOLVED. IN THIS REGARD THE DAILY SORTIE RATE ASSUMED FOR COMUSMACV PARTICIPATION IS:

A. VNAF - A1H: 13 SORTIES/DAY

B. FARMGATE - A1E; 13 SORTIES/DAY

6. REALIZING THAT PACIFICATION PROGRAM AND ARVN SUPPORT MUST BE CONSIDERED AT THE TIME DECISION IS MADE TO CONDUCT STRIKES AGAINST NVN, REQUIREMENT EXISTS TO PROVIDE LATITUDE AND SELECTIVITY REQUIRED BY REF A. AS A RESULT, THE SCHEDULING OF THE BELOW LISTED TARGETS FOR STRIKES BY VNAF/FARMGATE MAY APPEAR OUT OF PROPORTION TO FORCE INVOLVED, BUT IS NECESSARY TO PROVIDE FOR THE AFOREMENTIONED SELECTIVITY

SOME OVERLAP IN PREPARATION OF DETAILED STRIKE PLANS BETWEEN CINCPACAF/ CINCPACFLT AND COMUSMACV FOR INCLUSION IN THE 37 PLAN ANNEX WILL BE APPARENT, HOWEVER, THIS IS NECESSARY TO ACCOMMODATE SCHEDULING OF STRIKES TO COVER THE FOUR ATTACK OPTIONS, IN ADDITION TO SELECTIVITY.
